Jefferson School District 251 will be open with safety and health protocols in place to mitigate and limit the spread of COVID-19. To make each of these possible scenarios easy to remember and implement, they have each been assigned a color:

<b>MINIMAL RISK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Five days of school per week schedule</li><li>• School buildings will be cleaned and disinfected according to the CDC guidelines</li><li>• Buses will be cleaned and disinfected according to the CDC guidelines; students are encouraged to wear a mask since physical distancing protocols cannot be maintained on buses</li><li>• School lunches will be staggered to limit the number of students in the cafeteria and hallways</li><li>• Physical distancing protocols will be followed when possible</li><li>• Limited use of shared supplies and material</li><li>• Field trips, assemblies and large group activities may be limited</li><li>• Safety protocols in place for volunteers and visitors</li></ul>
<b>MODERATE RISK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Four days of school per week schedule. Monday will be an online learning day.</li><li>• All safety precautions in green will be followed during the moderate risk level</li><li>• School lunches will be staggered to limit the number of students in the cafeteria, hallways and alternate areas for students to eat lunch will be established</li><li>• Field trips, assemblies and large group activities will be limited to ensure physical distancing can be accomplished</li></ul>
<b>HIGH RISK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• All safety precautions in green and yellow will be followed during the high-risk level</li><li>• Students with last names beginning with A-L will attend on Tuesday and Thursday and students with last names beginning with M-Z will attend Wednesday and Friday</li><li>• Days when students are not in school are designated online learning days; Monday will be online learning day for all students; schools will be deep cleaned and sanitized on Mondays</li><li>• The district will offer internet access in parking lots</li><li>• School events and gatherings will have no spectators, or the number of spectators will be limited depending on venue and ability to effectively physical distance</li></ul>
<b>CRITICAL RISK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Reduce the risk of further community spread by closing the schools</li><li>• All students in an on-line remote learning model with focused, rigorous instruction on key standards in each grade and content area and traditional grades and accountability</li><li>• There may be opportunities for in-person small group instruction or interventions</li><li>• Closed campuses to the public, except by appointment</li><li>• No extracurricular activities or special events in district</li></ul>
