

Jefferson Joint School District 251 COVID-19 Decision Tree

Have you had close contact with someone that has tested positive for COVID-19 or you have had close contact (within 6 feet for more than 15 minutes) with a person *WITH A MORE COMMON SYMPTOM OR MULTIPLE LESS COMMON SYMPTOMS of COVID-19?

Were you wearing a face covering?

Continue

Self-isolate for 14 days in accordance with CDC guidelines. Conduct daily monitoring of your health. Continue attending school, wear a mask, and have daily temperature checks at school. If *SYMPTOMS appear, seek the evaluation of a medical provider.

*If contact was with a member of the household self-isolate for 14 days.

*SYMPTOMS MAY APPEAR 2-14 DAYS AFTER EXPOSURE TO THE VIRUS AND INCLUDE:

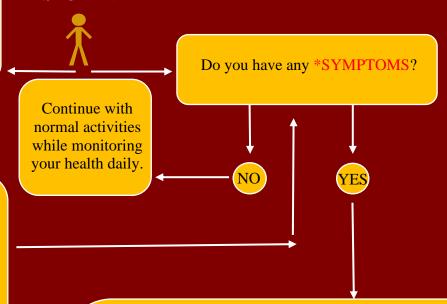
More Common Symptoms:

- Fever greater than or equal to 100.4 F
- New onset and/or worsening occupy, difficulty breathing
- New loss of taste or smell

Less Common Symptoms:

- Sore throat
- Nausea
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Chills
- Muscle Pain
- Excessive Fatigue
- New onset of severe headache or nasal congestion or runny nose

Seek the evaluation of a medical provider to determine if COVID-19 testing is indicated.

If testing is indicated, please ISOLATE until test results are received.

If test result is **POSITIVE**, continue to **ISOLATE** and local public health will contact you to follow up.

If no testing is conducted, you should ISOLATE for at least 10 days after symptom onset AND until symptoms have improved, including being fever-free for 24 hours without use of fever-reducing medications.
