

**ORDER ON MOTION TO DISMISS  
INDICTMENT**

Before the Court is Defendant's Motion to Dismiss the Indictment. After preserving the issue during the pendency of the preparation of the transcripts for the grand jury proceedings, Defendant filed his motion to dismiss with supporting memoranda on March 8, 2022. The State objected. A hearing on the motion took place on March 23, 2022. Based upon the briefing and oral arguments presented, the Court issued a written Memorandum Decision and Order denying the motion. The memorandum decision and order is sealed due to the requirements that grand jury proceedings—including the identity of grand jurors—be kept confidential. However, in consideration of I.C.A.R. 32 and the public's right to information on criminal proceedings, the Court acknowledges that the Defendant Chad Guy Daybell's Motion to Dismiss the Indictment is DENIED, without prejudice.
